## **John Clauscen Murray HDR Scholarship in Bowel Cancer Research**

A generous donation from the late John Clauscen Murray enables the University to offer a supplementary scholarship to encourage research in bowel cancer.

### **1. Purpose**

This scholarship is available to encourage and assist a student enrolled in a Higher Degree by Research to undertake research into bowel cancer.

### **2. Details**

Support type: supplementary stipend scholarship  
Value: \$10,000 per annum (stipend)  
Tenure: duration of primary award

### **3. Eligibility**

Citizenship: domestic or international  
Degree type: Doctor of Philosophy (00810), Master of Philosophy (00710)  
Attendance type: full-time (or part-time if primary award is part-time)  
Enrolment type: commencing

### **4. Specific eligibility requirement**

- a. This scholarship will be awarded through a competitive selection process to the highest ranked eligible applicant—who is not already in receipt of a similar award—based on academic merit.
- b. A supplementary stipend scholarship recipient must hold a RTP or equivalent primary stipend.
- c. Applicants must demonstrate a clear intent to undertake research into bowel cancer.

### **5. Exclusions**

This scholarship does not include provision for parental leave or extended sick leave and will be suspended during this type of leave.

### **6. Application process**

Applicants must apply as outlined on relevant UWA websites by the advertised closing date.

An application must clearly indicate the proposed research is in the field of bowel cancer with evidence of support by the proposed academic supervisor.

### **7. Awarding and administering office**

This scholarship is awarded and administered by the HDR Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Medical School.

### **8. Recipient's obligation**

The recipient of this scholarships is obliged to:

- (i) apply themselves diligently and to the best of their ability to successfully complete their degree.



- (ii) acknowledge the support of this scholarship in any publication, presentation or thesis resulting from research funded by this scholarship. This should include a statements such as:

*"This research was carried out while the author was in receipt of the John Clausen Murray HDR Scholarship in Bowel Cancer Research at The University of Western Australia".*
