This document contains important information regarding this philanthropic scholarship and must be read in conjunction with the UWA Stipend and Allowance Scholarship Conditions. Scholarship recipients are expected to understand and comply with the requirements outlined in both documents.

Ken Clements PhD Scholarship

This scholarship is established by Dr Diane Smith-Gander AO, in recognition of Emeritus Professor Ken Clements and his longstanding contribution to the profession and dedication to PhD candidates.

1. Purpose

This scholarship is offered to encourage and support a domestic female PhD candidate undertaking research in the field of economics.

2. Details

Type: top-up stipend (recipient must hold a RTP or equivalent primary stipend)

Value: \$27,750 per annum

Allowance: \$7,250 per annum research and travel allowance

Tenure: three years maximum

3. Eligibility

Citizenship: domestic Gender: female

Degree: Doctor of Philosophy (PhD 00810)

Enrolment: full-time (or part-time if primary stipend is awarded for part-time enrolment)

4. Specific eligibility requirement

This scholarship will be awarded to a domestic female student who can demonstrate that their intended research is in the field of economics.

It will be awarded via a competitive selection process to the highest ranked eligible applicant on the basis of academic merit.

5. Application process

Applicants must apply as outlined on relevant UWA websites by the advertised closing date.

6. Awarding and administering body

This scholarship is awarded and administered by the HDR Scholarship Committee on the recommendation of Emeritus Professor Ken Clements, or his nominee within the UWA Business School.

The research and travel allowance will be managed by the UWA Business School.

7. Recipient's obligation

The recipient is obliged to:

- (i) apply themselves diligently and to the best of their ability to successfully complete the degree.
- (ii) acknowledge the support of this scholarship in any publication, presentation, or thesis resulting from research funded by the scholarship. This should include a statement such as:

"This research was carried out while the author was in receipt of the Ken Clements PhD Scholarship at The University of Western Australia."
